Our MONOÏ OIL from Tahiti is made from an enflourage of Tiaré flowers in refined coconut oil. This process is the traditional way of producing Monoï oil in Tahiti, since centuries.

Tahitian women like to use the Monoï oil as hair oil and to protect their skin from the sun.
